POSITION SUMMARY: The principal function of an employee in this position is to maintain constant surveillance of patrons in the facility, both in the pool and on the deck area, acting immediately and appropriately to secure the safety of patrons in the event of an emergency. The individual in this position is also responsible for providing emergency care and treatment as required until the arrival of emergency medical services personnel. Due to the hours of operation, working hours for this position vary and may include weekends and evenings. This employee works under the direct supervision of the Aquatic Center Manager and the general supervision of the Parks & Recreation Superintendent. The principal duties of this position are performed in a general office and aquatic environment.

- Demonstrated ability to follow oral and written instruction
- Demonstrated ability to utilize electronic and manual office equipment;
- Demonstrated effective communications, both written and oral;
