The City of Blackfoot, in southeastern Idaho, is centrally located between BYU- Idaho and Idaho State University and within an easy drive of Yellowstone National Park and Jackson, Wyoming. Blackfoot is the county seat of Bingham County, home of the Eastern Idaho State Fair and is also a community with agriculture as its focus. Working for the City in this capacity benefits our community by ensuring that our bio-solids are removed safely and effectively.

**POSITION SUMMARY:** Working under the direct supervision of the Wastewater Treatment Plant Supervisor, and under the general supervision of the Wastewater Superintendent, the primary function of an employee in this position is to load, transport and unload bio-solids from the Wastewater Treatment Plant to a remote location for further degradation. All applicable Federal, State, County, City and other applicable public health environmental and safety standards must be maintained, as well as DOT regulations and rules. Daily inspection of the vehicles must be conducted and any mechanical or equipment failures must be documented and communicated to the appropriate staff person. The individual in this position may also perform other job related duties as assigned.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- High School Diploma, or GED equivalent
- Technical training highly desirable
- Class B CDL in good standing, with tanker, air brake and standard endorsements
- Ability to work independently on assigned tasks
- Accurately follow written and oral instructions
- Communicate effectively both verbally and in writing
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with supervisors, other City employees, and the public
- Sufficient personal mobility, flexibility, stamina and balance to work in an outdoor environment under adverse weather conditions
