Old Business:

- LTHAC Fisher St Project
 - Gale Lim will be the contractor and a preconstruction meeting will be scheduled soon.
 - Construction will begin right after school ends.
 - Walker to South will be done before New School year starts.
- One-way couplet & Downtown parking study draft
 - Aubrey found and is looking into grant called Safe streets and road for all that helps fund planning and public safety research.
 - Commission members will travel the route and talk to businesses.
 - Dropped from Agenda until study has been completed.
- Discuss Safety on Streets
 - Curtis Cannon proposes right turn only out of Arby's/Burger King
 - Dennis Parker suggests requesting Burger King/Arby's remove evergreens.
 - Have PD check the site triangle in that area and see if those are out of ordinance. (40 ft from center line and less than 3 feet tall from grade.)
 - Chief Croft noted several areas of safety concern – Tabled

 2. 45 to 35 SB 91 @ Rich Ln

New Business:

- Check the shrubbery at Riverton and Camas for view obstruction.
- Paul Loomis questioned 20 MPH on Lilac when Last Street is not, Scott will be looking into why that is not 25.
- Downtown Sewer upgrade study has uncovered several obstacles from old pipes and utility lines.
- LHTAC is looking at funding for Pendlebury between Alice to Christensen that will be available FY 25.
