APPROVE MEETING MINUTES

Commissioner Ramirez motioned to approve the minutes from the May 14, 2019 meeting as written; Commissioner Thomas seconded; all were in favor, motion carried.

Commissioner Jefferis opened the meeting to City Attorney Sandow

Attorney Garrett Sandow addressed the public at the P & Z meeting explaining that because of the number of patrons present there was no possible way to hold the meeting while fulfilling the requirements of the open meeting law. He felt that those present would not be able to hear all wishing to voice their opinion. Therefore, we will have to reschedule this meeting at a different date and time with a change of venue.

Commissioner Ramirez questioned if there was any way the two business items involving BCCLC Elementary and BCCLC Middle School could be postponed but discuss two other topics, i.e., the Conditional Use Permit for Amy Mow, and the zone change approval on the residential ranchettes. Attorney Sandow assured the Commission that all of the issues would need to schedule a meeting at another time, possibly at the Nuart or the Blackfoot Performing Arts Center where there would be ample room for all interested patrons to be present.

The Commissioners discussed changing the meeting for BCCLC to June 25th, to be held in a location that will accommodate the number of people desiring to participate. The exact location will be determined when we receive permission to use one of these buildings. The

Commissioners confirmed that the meeting would be scheduled for its regular time of 7 p.m.

Commissioner Ramirez motioned to defer the entire agenda until our scheduled June 11th and June 25th meetings. The meeting on the 11th will be in the City Council Chambers while the meeting location on the 25th will be determined and a notification will be posted. Commissioner Barlow seconded; all were in favor, motion carried.

(NOTE: Due to scheduling conflicts, the meeting for 11 June was changed to a special Planning and Zoning Commission meeting to be held on 18 June. Proper notification and advertisement for this special meeting were given.)
