MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER 26, 2023**

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Mayor Carroll called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**ROLL CALL**

Those in attendance were: Councilman Brown, Councilman Gardner, Councilman Jensen, and Councilwoman Simpson.

**CITY TREASURER GRAHM ANDERSON**

**Public Hearing on Reopening the 2023 FY Budget**

City Treasurer, Graham Anderson, presented a proposed amendment for the FY 2023 budget as was published. The overrun in expenses was due to grants received, as well as from street projects that went over their budget from issues that were not foreseen. Mayor Carroll requested that we entertain a motion to move into public hearing, Councilman Gardner made a motion to go into Public Hearing, Councilman Brown seconded the motion, all were in favor and the meeting moved into a Public Hearing. No one was signed up to speak at the public hearing. There were no questions. Councilman Jensen made a motion to move out of the public hearing, Councilman Gardner seconded, all were in favor and the public hearing moved back into the regular meeting agenda.

**Proposed Ordinance Reopening the 2023 FY Budget**

Mr. Anderson proposed a motion for approval of Ordinance No. 2245 for the Annual appropriation amendment for the FY 2023 budget. Councilman Gardner motioned to approve Ordinance No. 2245 as presented and waive all readings, Councilman Jensen seconded the motion; on a roll call vote, all were in favor, motion carried.

**ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS AMENDMENT 2022-2023**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLACKFOOT, IDAHO, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2225, THE APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022, APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONIES THAT ARE TO BE RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF BLACKFOOT, IDAHO IN THE SUM OF \$430,000; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Blackfoot, Bingham County, Idaho:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 2225, the appropriations ordinance for the City of Blackfoot, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2022, be, and the same is hereby amended as follows:

That the additional amount of \$430,000 be appropriated out of the revenues of the Airport Fund, Street Fund, and Parks & Rec Fund to be used for authorized activities.

Section 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take affect and be in full force upon its passage, approval, and publication in one issue of the Post Register, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Blackfoot, and official newspaper of the said City.

PASSED under suspension of rules upon which a roll call vote was taken and duly enacted an Ordinance of the City of Blackfoot, Bingham County, Idaho at a convened meeting of the City of Blackfoot City Council held on the 26th day of September 2023.
